Global Council Meeting

The Global Council was scheduled to meet at the Dubai conference. Since we did not meet in March, the Global Council met on April 16 with a full agenda. The Zoom platform was used and worked very well. Much of the meeting was spent discussing the Coronavirus and its impact on our organization. The scheduled conferences were reviewed and discussed by members of the Global Council. Recommendations were developed on the scheduled events and future conferences. Recommendations of local planning committees in their respective countries were approved.

Frederick Winslow Taylor Award

Dr. Hamid Parsaei discussed the background of the Frederick Winslow Taylor Award. The Global Council was delighted that his company, Integrated Technology Systems, Inc, has agreed to support this special IEOM Society Award. This recognition will be the most prestigious award that the IEOM Society has ever presented. Although other organizations also have a Frederick Winslow Taylor Award, the IEOM award will be unique. This award will recognize the exceptional contributions of individuals in the industrial engineering and operations management profession. The Global Council approved the award and thanked Dr. Parsaei for his continued support.

IEOM Society International 2020 Conferences and Symposiums

IEOM Society 10th Anniversary International Conference, Dubai, U.A.E. Due to the Coronavirus, this event was held using a virtual Zoom format, Dr. Ahad Ali, Dr. Hayder Zghair and Professor Don Reimer coordinated this event from the IEOM Society International office in Southfield, Michigan. The Zoom platform provided an opportunity for most of the participants to present their research over a five-day period. More than 150 PowerPoints were presented. The videos were uploaded to the IEOM Society YouTube site. Papers will be submitted to Scopus for indexing. The feedback received from the participants was positive.

The case study must illustrate Lean Six Sigma concepts that review the current Covid-19 pandemic. The goal is to develop a statistical analysis of global conditions to determine if differences exist between countries. In addition, a model curve should be created to determine the time frame to "Flatten the Curve" for a particular country or region. This case study will allow participating students to gain an awareness and knowledge of the impact of the pandemic. It will also demonstrate the application of DMAIC strategy to resolve complex processes.
